I. GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the 2011 Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines. Each year the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) issues poverty guidelines, which are published in the *Federal Register*. The 2011 HHS Poverty Guidelines are available. These guidelines were used to develop the income limits for the 150 and 200 percent income guidelines. See charts below:

200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines for 2011 – (Monthly Income Limits)

Family Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
200%	\$1,815	\$2,452	\$3,089	\$3,725	\$4,362	\$4,999	\$5,635	\$6,272

For each additional family member add \$637.

150% of Federal Poverty Guidelines for 2011– (Monthly Income Limits)

Family Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
150%	\$1,362	\$1,839	\$2,317	\$2,794	\$3,272	\$3,749	\$4,227	\$4,704

For each additional family member add \$478.
